Newcastle University Criminologist and Professor Roy Paulsen said: "It seems likely that he was in the long-term planning for this act. It would be more likely if he had firearms training and experience to use them. "He is not likely to have been acting alone. Given the nature of the crime, as well as the gun and ammunition, it is likely to be linked to organised crime." This is a public safety issue. We cannot know whether this man has been involved in other criminal activity. In these circumstances, there needs to be greater protection of the public. This is likely to involve the Police setting up a multi-agency task force involving the Police, Immigration, Customs and Border protection, and the Australian Federal Police. "The public has to be very vigilant. There is a good deal of evidence that organised criminals are in the firearm trade, perhaps acting as arms smugglers. They may be passing on the weapons to other criminals. "Part of this would be in arranging meetings with the new regime, including pre-arranged drop-off sites where the stolen firearms could be picked up. "These meetings are going to be highly vulnerable. Someone who knows about their criminal activities would be very likely to inform the authorities. They may be planning a drop-off site. Some of the arms may be locked away with a trusted family member or friend." Paulsen said that, in such cases, it is very difficult for the Police to arrest the supplier of the firearms because they cannot prove he was the actual supplier. "The gun will have been bought from an arms retailer. If it is a long-arm, he would need a licence to possess it, and that licence has to be current. "The Arms Act 1994 requires that a licence is valid for only 12 months, but many retailers will keep a stock of unlicensed weapons. If they are not licensed, they are classed as prohibited weapons. Anyone possessing one of these weapons would have committed an offence." He said that, in this case, it would be very difficult to find out the man's identity, as it may be a fake name. " 82157476af
